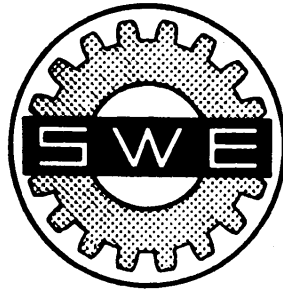

I Progress towards Grant Project

Both Sierra Nevada Women's Engineering Forums have been completed. One was on September 20, 2001 from 6-9 pm, and the second was on March 23, 2002 from 10 am – 2 pm.

The September Forum had a panel of 4 professionals and 4 students. Each forum member presented her experience in engineering, and then the forum fielded questions. The forum section of the event lasted approximately one hour and was followed by 2 presentations by UNR women engineering students. There were three engineering student presentations including Vomit Comet by Deb Willems. Also, there were several hands-on exhibits set up including an electrical-mechanical interface by Helen Zeisloft and a computer science experiment by Dorothy Cheung. Many students included design projects to demonstrate the different disciplines of engineering.

The March event was attended by Nancy Nelson, our Region A director, 5 professional members, and several UNR students. We conducted the main event in a circle and had an intimate question and answer session. We also did brainstorming on where women in engineering could go and how to get there by 2020.
