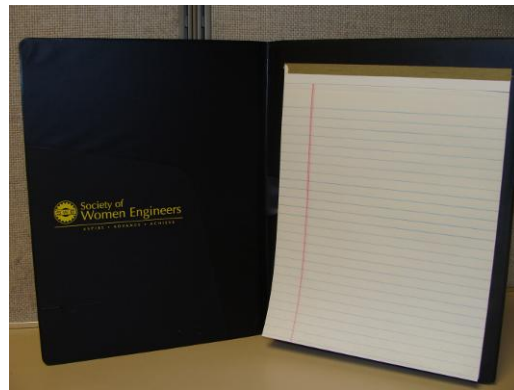


SWE Membership info:
